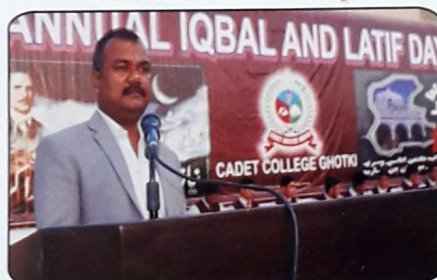
United Nations Day

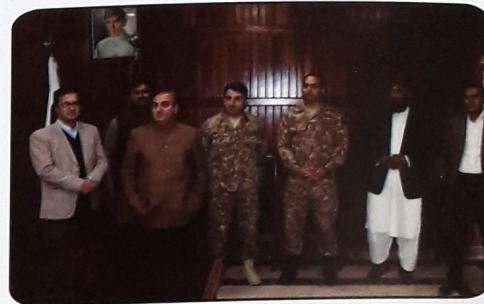
